This year, 2022, will be a year of great justice and emergence in the power of God's Word in Jesus' name.


Romans 3:26

7 STEPS OF PRAYER

Effective and continual prayer must be released and agreed upon in the Spirit, in alignment with the Word of God, with sincerity.

Step 1 - Abide in Christ the Vine

We must be in alignment with Christ. (Acts 17:28)

Step 2 - Pray in Faith

Without faith, it is impossible to please God. (Acts 4:23-31, 1 Timothy 2:8)

Step 3 - Stand on God's Word

The Word of God never fails. (Ephesians 6:13)

Step 4 - Pray in the Spirit

We must worship in Spirit and truth. (Jude 1:20)

Step 5 - Persevere in Prayer

The effectual fervent prayer of the righteous avails. (Matthew 6:16-18)

Step 6 - Use Different Types of Prayer

We should always pray and not faint.

Type 1 – Worship and Praise

Type 2 – Petition and Intercession


Type 3 – Supplication

Type 4 – Thanksgiving

Type 5 – Spiritual Warfare

Step 7 - Flow in God's Love

8 WAYS TO PRAY EFFECTIVELY

Know to whom you are speaking.

Know to whom you are speaking.


Prayer is a conversation with God, and every conversation begins by addressing the person to whom you are speaking by name. Jesus begins prayer with, "Our Father in heaven." He focuses on a distinct person — the Heavenly Father with whom He has a personal relationship. We share the same right to call God "Father," and there are times when we need to talk with our Abba Father, Daddy God. But God is three distinct persons in One: The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. (Matthew 28:19, 2 Corinthians 13:14, 1 Corinthians 12:4-5)

Thank God.

A heartfelt thank you is always a great conversation starter. Like any parent, God loves to see that we have grateful hearts. But more importantly, as we take the time to praise God for all He has done in the past — the answered prayers, the impossible situations overcome, the healings and grace — our faith to believe for even greater answers to prayer grows stronger and more confident. Praise opens the gates of heaven and should always be part of our alone time with God. (1 Thessalonians 5:16-18, Psalm 103:1-4, Colossians 2:6-7, Isaiah 12:4-5)

Ask for God's will.

The Lord's Prayer is not the only place where Jesus modeled a heart of obedience and submission to the will of God over His own desires and needs. In the Garden of Gethsemane, only hours before Jesus'

crucifixion, He would once again pray, “not my will, but yours be done.” In a world where right and wrong are frequently confused and the future is so uncertain, it can be hard to know how to pray or what to ask for when difficult circumstances arise. But the one thing we can know with absolute certainty is that God’s plan for those who love Him is good and the safest place we can be is in the center of His divine will. (Psalm 25:4-5, Proverbs 19:21, Matthew 6:9-10)

Say what you need.


In Jesus’ time, bread was a staple — one of the most basic needs of life — and He did not hesitate to ask God to provide it. But we often hesitate to bother God with the little things we need, thinking He should not be bothered. And when the big problems come, we try everything we can to solve the problem before we think to pray. The Bible says, “You do not have because you do not ask God.” So never hesitate to ask God for what you need in 2022. Your Father in heaven delights to give you good gifts. (James 4:2-3, Matthew 7:7-8,11)

Ask for forgiveness.

James 5:16 reminds us that if we want our prayers to be heard, our hearts need to be right with God and with one another. If you feel your prayers are bouncing off the ceiling, take some time to check your heart. (James 5:16, Matthew 6:14-15, Psalm 50:4-5)

Pray with a friend.

There is power in agreement when we pray in Jesus’ name. When I have an urgent need to take before the throne of God, I will often call a friend to pray with me. If you do not already have one, make finding a trusted prayer partner one of your goals in 2022. (Matthew 18:19-20, Ephesians 4:1-6, Psalm 133:1-3, James 5:14-15)

Pray the Word.

The Word of God has power and is one of our greatest spiritual weapons. (Hebrews 4:12, 2 Timothy 3:16-17, James 1:22, Ephesians 6:10-18)

Memorize Scripture.

The most important key to a vibrant prayer life is to understand our spiritual authority in Christ as explained in the Scriptures. The only way to do that is to become intimately familiar with the Bible. Even a few minutes a day in the Word of God will add strength and authority to your prayers in 2022. (1 Peter 1:23, Psalm 119:11, Matthew 4:4)

THE PURPOSE OF PRAYER

Prayer is an act of communication with God.

God calls us to pray to develop and deepen our relationship with Him. God wants friendship. Jesus said in John 15:14-15 (NIV), "You are My friends if you do what I command you. No longer do I call you servants, for a servant does not understand what his master is doing."

Prayer is an act that shows our dependence on God.

Prayer is an admission that we need God's help to live a fruitful and productive life. When we look at Jesus' life, it was prayer that allowed Him to excel. In John 5:19, Jesus said, "I tell you the truth, the Son can do nothing by himself; he can do only what he sees his Father doing." Jesus was essentially saying that on His own He did not have the insight or the ability to live an


extraordinary life. Mark 1:35 (NIV) says, “Very early in the morning, while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left the house and went off to a solitary place, where he prayed.” Jesus’ example is clear. To know and to do His Father’s will, He had to depend upon His Father in prayer. If Jesus needed to pray and was dependent upon God through prayer, we certainly need to do the same.

Prayer is an act of making my requests KNOWN to God.

In John 15:7 Jesus says, “If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be given you.” This is a blank check drawn on the ‘Bank of Heaven,’ and it is signed by Jesus Himself. God wants us to ask Him for what we want and need from Him. The Bible says, “Tell God what you need,” in Philippians 4:6 (NLT) Prayer is an act of making our requests KNOWN to God.

Prayer is an act of cooperation with God.

Prayer is God’s way of letting us partner with Him to accomplish His purposes. In the Lord’s Prayer from Matthew 6:9-10 (NIV), Jesus taught His disciples to pray by saying, “Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.” In our prayers, we learn more about His will and play our role in accomplishing His plans. In many situations, God waits on us to ask before He acts – and so, when we do pray, the impossible becomes possible.

Day 1:



Day 6



Day 14



Day 18




